Is Associate Director at the United Nations University Institute on Comparative Regional Integration Studies (UNU-CRIS) in Bruges since 2008. He has been a Visiting Lecturer at the UN University for Peace (San José), the Universidad de Los Andes (Bogotá), and the Prague School of Economics. He has been involved in policy research and consultancy projects for the governments of Belgium, Flanders, France, Colombia and Thailand, the UN, ILO, OECD, European Commission and EUROSTAT. Dr. De Lombaerde is an economist whose current research interests include: regional economic integration, international trade, monitoring tools and indicators, comparative regionalism, Latin American regionalism, EU external policy, cross-border micro-regions.
