
Mississippi Profile




- Population 2.98 mil
- 51% live in rural areas
- Poverty rate highest of all US states (25%)
- African American poverty rate in Mississippi is 42%
- Delta region highest poverty rates in state
- Ranks last of all states in health outcomes
- In 2013, Mississippi was
 - First in the United States in death rates (per 100k) for heart disease and hypertension/renal failure
 - Second in the U.S. in death rates for cancer, diabetes, kidney disease and blood poisoning
 - Third in the U.S. in death rates for stroke and homicide
- Mississippi also led the United States in the motor vehicle death rate and child death rate, ages 1-14

HIV/AIDS in the South & Mississippi





- Mississippi is 32nd in population, in 2010 it ranked 7th in the nation for HIV/AIDS prevalence
- Estimates of "unmet need" at least 50 percent, significantly higher than the national average of 33 percent
- Percentage of people in Mississippi with HIV not receiving care or support services is comparable to that in Botswana, Ethiopia, and Rwanda
