Health financing must be at the core of these discussions if we are to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and the vision set out in the WHO's 13th General Programme of Work for the coming five years. This event will serve to achieve a better understanding of the roles and opportunities that both donors and recipient countries have in ensuring long-term, sustained and positive health outcomes when donor funding and support reduces and/or changes in nature.
