BACKGROUND AND MISSION

Medicus Mundi International - Network Health for All (MMI) is a network of organisations working in the field of international health cooperation and global health. The Network promotes access to health and health care as a fundamental human right and supports the efforts undertaken in this respect by its members. MMI is an NGO in official relations with the World Health Organization. As of 2019, the network is comprised of 20 members based in 11 countries, with two members being international networks.

HEALTH-RELATED ACTIVITIES

MMI organises events and networking opportunities to foster a critical reflection on international health cooperation amongst both NGOs and international organisations and is part of a broader civil society team undertaking advocacy at the WHO in fields related to access to health care and global health governance. It also maintains working groups on global health governance and effective health cooperation. MMI promotes health for all and the right to health and amplifies the voices of its network members. Since 2016 MMI hosts the civil society Geneva Global Health Hub (G2H2).

GOVERNANCE AND STAFF

MMI is governed by a 7-member board. President of MMI and Chairperson of the Board is Carlos Mediano and the Executive Secretary is Thomas Schwarz. Members of the board (chairperson, 2 vice-chairpersons, secretary, treasurer and two ordinary members) are elected for a term of three years by the general assembly, which meets once per year.

FUNDING SOURCES AND BUDGET

MMI is funded through membership contributions, extraordinary contributions by members and revenue generated through projects and grants. Total revenue in 2018 was EUR 91'258 and 90% of expenses were due to secretariat, travel and event costs.
