Cogito Foundation	Postdoctoral Scholarships	Postdocs	To support cross- disciplinary projects that bridge the sciences and the humanities. See <u>funded projects</u> for examples.	Generally, less than CHF 100,000 for up to 3 years.	
European Commission	Marie Skłodowska- Curie Individual Fellowships	Postdocs	To provide European or Global post-doctoral fellowships in all disciplines. Applicants must have completed their PhD no more than 4-years before applying, and have at least 1 year of research work experience since their PhD.
Swiss National Science Foundation	<u>Eccellenza</u>	Postdocs	To support highly qualified postdocs who want to lead an independent research project in Switzerland.	Applicants salary and up to CHF 1'000'000 in research funds over 5 years.	Applicants must be within 8 years of obtaining their PhD to apply and must have at least 3 years postdoc experience.
Swiss National Science Foundation	<u>Prima</u>	Postdocs	To support excellent female researchers who wish to conduct an independent research project in Switzerland.	The applicant's salary, plus up to CHF 750,000 for research expenses over 5 years.	Applicants must submit their application between 2-10 years after completing their PhD and have completed at least 2-years of research experience after their PhD.
Swiss National Science Foundation	Postdoc.Mobility	Postdocs	To support Swiss postdocs who wish to conduct a research stay abroad.
