
THE MEETING CENTRE: PROFESSIONAL COMFORT

The Meeting Centre can host, with the highest quality service and performance available, groups of different sizes (between 8 and 140 people) for various activities including general assemblies, seminars, workshops, arbitration hearings and diplomatic negotiations. The Centre is furnished, managed and equipped in order to satisfy the most demanding requirements:

- → Office area (printing, scanning and photocopying)


Two spaces with separated entrances

- → A 228 m² plenary room (C1)
- → Four meeting rooms (C2, C3, C4, C5)



Plenary room C1

This room's configuration can host between 30 and 140 people with the different configurations below. The rental price is based on the standard layout only. Any arrangement other than the standard layout is subject to additional costs.



Four meeting rooms (C2, C3, C4, C5)

Depending on their configuration, the four meeting rooms can host between 8 and 30 people. The rental price is based on the standard layout (rectangle). Any arrangement other than the standard layout is subject to additional costs.

Catering

The Meeting Centre has a reception area measuring 115 m² and a room (C5) suited for coffee breaks, lunches and cocktails. Direct access to the Restaurant de la Maison de la paix situated on the 8th floor of petal 5 is also available. The Restaurant's terrace offers sweeping views of Geneva, the Alps and Lake Geneva.





In the heart of International Geneva

Owned by the Graduate Institute, the Maison de la paix, situated in the heart of the International Geneva, has a Meeting Centre situated in petals 5 and 6. For higher-capacity needs, auditoriums of various sizes (92, 210, 348 or 558 places) are available in petals 1 and 2.

Access

The Meeting Centre is easily accessible from **Genève-Cornavin railway station** (5 minutes by tram or train), **the airport** (15 minutes by bus or taxi) or **the A1 motorway** (5 minutes from Genève Grand-Saconnex exit). **The Sécheron public parking** is a 3 minutes' walk.
