


Jacques Moreillon | Class of 1971

After six visits to Nelson Mandela, the prisoner, Jacques Moreillon kept close contact with the "free" great man. Here we see them reunited in 2003 at the British Red Cross "Humanity Award" ceremony where Jacques Moreillon presented the award to Mandela. Member of the ICRC Directorate from 1975 to 1988, he was successively Director of the Department of Doctrine and Law (as successor to Jean Pictet), then Director of General Affairs and finally Director General of the ICRC ad personam from 1984.
