

## Maurice Kamga | Class of 2003

Professor Maurice Kengne Kamga is a Senior Cameroonian diplomat (Minister Plenipotentiary) and a prominent scholar, who has also been a judge of the International Tribunal for the Law of the Sea (ITLOS) since 2020. Professor Kamga has been, *inter alia*, an Assistant Lecturer at the University of Yaoundé II (1993-1997), a Legal Officer at the International Criminal Tribunal for former Yugoslavia (1997-2001) and at ITLOS (2001-2003), the Legal Advisor of the Cameroonian Ministry of External Relations (2003-2008), and a Legal Secretary of the International Court of Justice (2008-2020). He has lectured in various African and European universities and has published several articles and books in International Law.
