

# Workflow French Course



# **Detailed Description:**

## **Proof of French Level:**

Must be submitted before Start of Academic Year

- 1. Native French speaker (secondary or post-secondary diploma taught entirely in French), OR
- 2. Completed one academic year studying at university level, full-time, entirely in French, OR
- 3. Obtained a French language certificate equivalent to a DELF B1 level.

# Workflow French Course - Detailed Description

### French Test level B1:

First week of the academic year

- 1. Designed to evaluate your passive knowledge of French (indicative of your ability to follow a course taught in French)
- 2. Consists of:
  - a. Listening & Reading Comprehension,
  - b. Grammar & Vocabulary Exercises,
  - c. Multiple Choice Section
  - d. Short Writing Section

## **Intensive French Course:**

3 Weeks before start of Academic year

- Online **individual placement test** in order to be placed into different level groups (from beginner to intermediate)
- Regular attendance: missing more than two class sessions, without written justification, leads to automatic withdrawal from the semester course.
- 20 hours per week, morning or afternoon
- Course materials need to be purchased on the first day of class (approx CHF 35).
  Otherwise, no course fee.

#### **Annual French Course:**

Starting for First Week of the Semester

- Two hours per week during Semester I & II
- Worth 3 ECTS
  - MINT: Will count as a 3 ECTS skills workshop
  - **Disciplinary Master programmes**: Will count as a 3 ECTS complementary course taken outside the discipline
  - PhD programmes: Will appear on the transcript and be counted 3 ECTS in addition to the required credits

#### 1. Requirement:

- a. **Successful completion** of the French Course: indicated as *pass/fail* on the transcript.
- b. Regular Attendance: more than 2 unjustified absences will result in a *fail* assessment.
